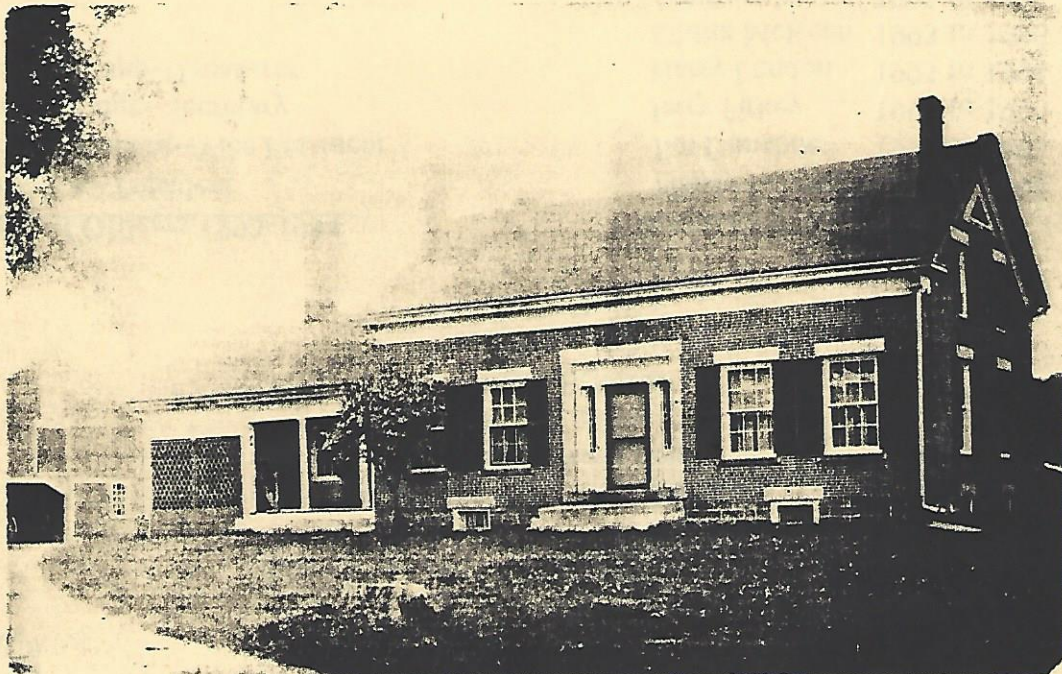
None of this could have been accomplished without the support of the officers and board members who gave so generously of their time. It has been a pleasure to have worked with them and I am most grateful to them.

Much still has to be done, particularly to parts of the outside of the building, especially the front doors. I know the new officers and board members will continue their efforts to improve our building and add to our inventory.

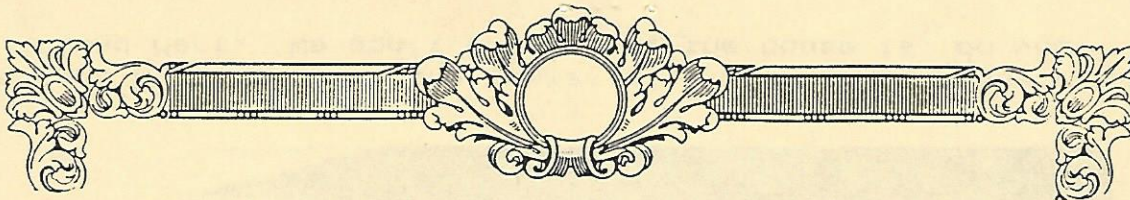
I would like to thank the Town of Essex and the Village of Essex Junction for their help and support, without which our task would be much more difficult.

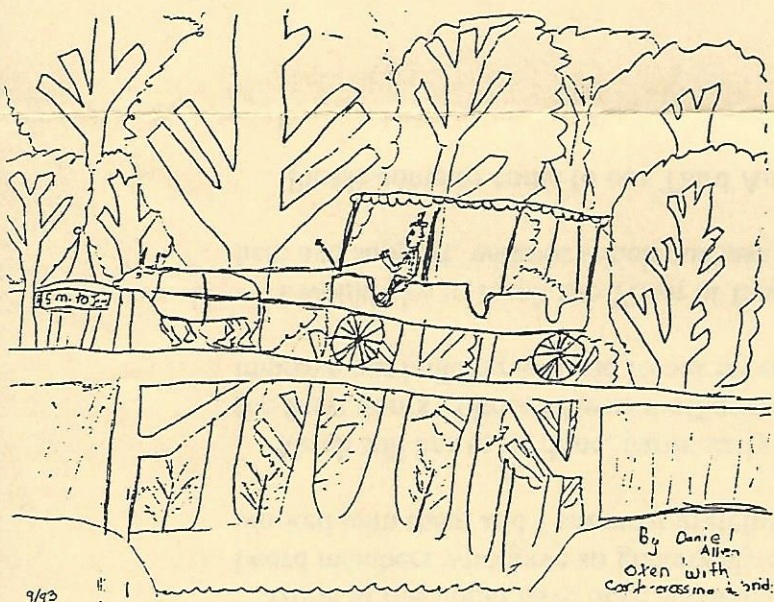

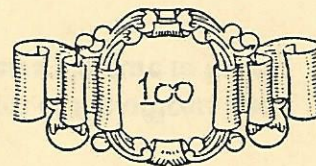
